AWARD PROGRAM FOR 2023 - 2024 SEASON

Attached is a listing of all awards included in the GRUSBC Awards Program for the 2023 - 2024 season. It is suggested that all Team Captains receive a copy before your league begins. Please feel free to make copies.

When the listing refers to "Entries", it is referring to the Year End drawing at the annual GRUSBC Association banquet. The drawing for the 2023 - 2024 season will be the same as last year. There will be three drawings for \$500 cash each and four drawings for \$25 cash each.

Also attached are forms for those League Secretaries submitting award requests manually. There are two forms for your use. They are:

1. Bowler Honor Award Request Form.
2. Bowler Award Request Form (The most frequent submission).

The top portion requesting League Name, Secretary Name, Bowling Center Name, and Secretary phone number on each form only needs to be completed once. It is not required on every award request. Please feel free to make copies as needed.

It is strongly encouraged that you submit award requests online. The online form can be found on the Association website bowlgr.com under the "links" tab.

Timely submission of award requests is required so awards can be delivered in a timely fashion. Requests must be submitted within 3 weeks of the date bowled.

The award program for the 2023-24 season has two major changes. First, the award for Women bowling a 225 to 289 game has been deleted. Second, a bowler may receive only one hat and one shirt per season. Additionally, the bowler must bowl at least 70 pins over average in a game, 100 pins over average in a series (or better) to claim a hat or shirt.

As a reminder, a bowler must bowl 12 games before earning an Over Average Award. The Over Average Awards include the 40-69 Pins Over for game, 70 Pins Over for game, and 100 plus Pins Over for Series. All other awards on forms one and two above or the online form can be earned at anytime.

Observations:

1. Please remember that a Senior is defined as a bowler age 55 or over.
2. For a given series a bowler can earn multiple awards for Over Average.

Please have your bowlers be on the lookout for achievements that are not visible by looking at the bowler's scores. Specifically, the 7-10 split conversion, Big 4 split conversion or an All Spare game cannot be determined by looking at game scores.

5. 11 in a Row	8 Entries and Plaque or Medallion
6. All Spare Game	10 Entries
7. Men's 700 Series	3 Entries or Trinket Award
8. Triplicate 200 Games	5 Entries and Acrylic
9. Triplicate Other	5 Entries and Engraved Beer Stein or Wine Glass
10.7-10 or Big 4 Conversion	5 Entries and Acrylic

Note: Men's 700 Series must also be at least 50 pins over average.

Bowlers Age 55 and Above	1 Entry or Trinket Award

12.70 Or More Pins Over Average for Game

70 -- 99 Pins Over Average	2 Entries or Trinket Award
100 -- 129 Pins Over Average	3 Entries or Trinket Award
130+ Pins Over Average	4 Entries or Trinket Award

13.100 Pins or More Over Average for Series

100 – 149 Pins Over Average	2 Entries or Trinket Award
150 – 199 Pins Over Average	3 Entries or Trinket Award
200+ Pins Over Average	4 Entries or Trinket Award

14. GRUSBC Hat and GRUSBC Shirt

70 Pins Over Average – Game	Hat or Shirt
100 Pins Over Average – Series	Hat or Shirt

Please Note: A bowler may request only one hat and one shirt per season.

Trinket Awards include pen, GRUSBC Hat, GRUSBC Shirt, GRUSBC Towel, koozie, coaster, or coffee mug. The koozie, coaster, and coffee mug are personalized with the bowler's name, bowling center, score, and date of achievement.
